356 solar panels installed on the on the Town Center's roof



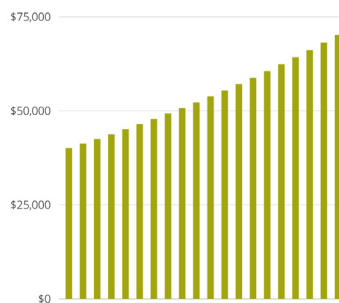
